Lecture/Discussion: Career Management in Classical Music

This short lecture and discussion will give an overview of the classical music industry and demonstrate how classical musicians can work on improving their own careers.

The requirements for being a successful classical musician have rapidly changed in the last decades. Mastering an instrument became the base for a 360-degree-profile of an artist. Participants of this lecture will gain an insight into the music market, strategic career planning, management processes, marketing skills and there will be room for discussion and questions.

The lecture will be followed by private career advice sessions on the next day.

Career Advice: Participants will receive private sessions of 30 minutes each in order to discuss questions about their personal careers. This can range from strategic questions, organisational questions, contract-issues to optimizing an artist-portfolio.
